Evaluation of the oral interview (Maximum score: 65/80)	The interview is aimed at ascertaining the preparation and aptitudes of candidates for scientific research and will include the assessment of the knowledge of the English language. The minimum score is 40/65 and the maximum is 65/80.			
Topics of the interview	The interview will focus on the research project proposed by each candidate and attached to the application.

The knowledge of the English language will be tested through a reading comprehension and translation test using an academic text or extract from a scientific journal.
