## Ancient Issues Relevant to Modern Times (History of Thought and Economic Theories)

Objective: The course is made of a group of two seminars, aiming at providing PhD students with an appraisal of the basic concepts utilised by contending views of the economy relevant for dealing with any specific issue, such as the agricultural sector and related policy issues.
